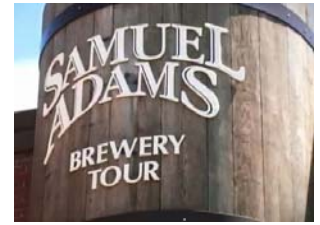




# BOSTON PILGRIMS & PATRIOTS

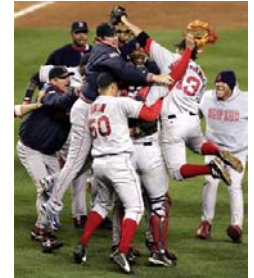
*Discover Boston, One of the oldest cities in United States!

- **Lunch at Cheers** – Grab a bite to eat at this famous pub known for year as the Bull & Finch Pub! Cheers, Beacon Hill is the original inspiration setting of the favorite American TV series.
